

Arduino IDE Install/Setup

1. Go to <https://www.arduino.cc/en/software/#ide> and download the latest Arduino IDE for your operating system. For Windows machines that is probably the “Windows 10 or newer (64-bit)” Version.
2. Run the installer, agree to the prompts about installing the USB drivers, etc..
3. Run the Arduino IDE.
 - a. Go to Tools → Board → Boards Manager...
 - b. In the search box type “espres” (Without the quotes)
 - c. Click the “INSTALL” button on the “esp32 by Espressif Systems” option.
4. Go to <https://explorers.joeysystems.net/acebott/> and download the WiFi_setup.zip file.
5. Copy the contents of the zip file to the Arduino libraries folder. (Documents\Arduino\libraries)
6. Go to <https://explorers.joeysystems.net/acebott/> and download the CarCamServer2.zip file.
7. Copy the contents of the zip file to the Arduino folder. (Documents\Arduino)
8. When your done the folders should look like this:
